## Abstract

The contribution examines the first editorial catalogue issued by Aldo Manuzio on 1 October 1498 and in particular the copy in the Österreichische Nationalbibliothek in Vienna (Ink. 7.A.13). A careful examination of the manuscript annotations, known to be by Hartmann Schedel, has enabled the author to identify the volume in which Schedel had the catalogue bound in his lifetime: a copy of Marcantonio Sabellico's Decades rerum Venetarum (Venice, Andrea Torresani, 1487) also in the Österreichische Nationalbibliothek (Ink. 7.A.7). A detailed description of the item and Schedel's textual and graphic additions reveals for the first time what was one of the most significant books in the Nuremberg humanist's library and allows us to reconstruct the context of his use in the years immediately following its publication.
