## Abstract

Achille Pellizzari's edition of Le opere di Francisco de Hollanda, published in two volumes in Naples in 1914 and 1915 respectively, was the outcome of an interest in the Portuguese painter which Pellizzari had cultivated since the age of twenty-five, reinforced by long and frequent visits to Spain and Portugal. The publication was intended to be part of a complete edition of the artist's writings and drawings. This programme of publication was interrupted during the Second World War; scholars of the work of Francisco de Holanda have only rarely paid attention to Pellizzari's study, copies of which are to be found only in a handful of libraries, and when they have, have not always cited it accurately.
